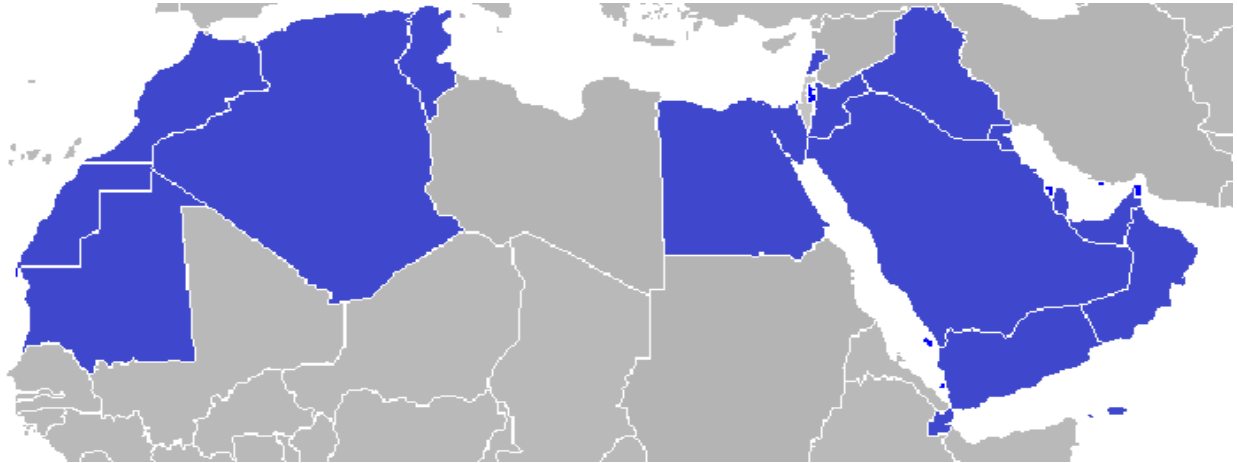

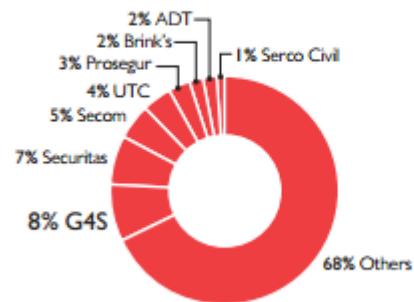
G4S is the biggest security company in the world and the largest employer on the London Stock Exchange (620,500 staff members). It has operations in 125 countries.

G4S is an international corporation that provides private security services and cash solutions to private companies and governments.

Turnover by segment 2012*

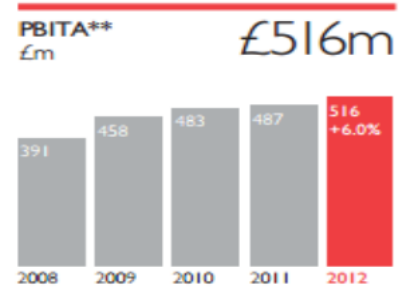
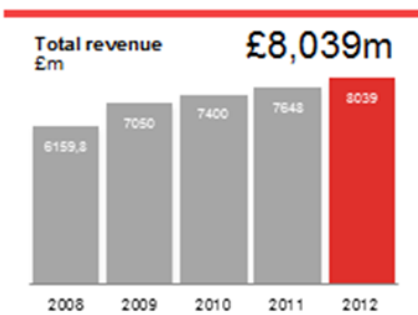

According to G4S' 2012 annual report, 59% of G4S' revenue comes from security solutions for private companies and individuals and 23% from security solutions for governments, and 8% comes from cash solutions, mainly outsourcing of cash cycle management for central banks, financial institutions and retailers.

Revenue and Profit in the Arab region:

G4S has operations in 16 Arab countries. The total revenue of the Middle East and Gulf States for 2012 was £501 million pounds (6.23% of total G4S revenue), and the profit from the region for the same year was over £33m, representing more than 6% of the total profit of the company. In contrast, G4S' revenue from operation in Israel amounts to £100million and estimated profit equals 1% of total company revenue according to the FT.

Staff:

G4S has 620,500 employees in the world, 44,500 in the Middle East and Gulf states securing among other things the pilgrimage to Mekka, the airports of Baghdad, Abu Dhabi and Dubai, embassies, sport events and private companies. This information does not account for Morocco, Tunisia, Algeria, Mauritania and Djibouti.

G4S in Israel:

In 2007, G4S signed a contract with the Israeli Prison Authority to provide security systems and other services for major Israeli prisons. G4S Israel (Hashmira), provides systems for the Ketziot and Megiddo prisons, which hold Palestinian political prisoners from occupied Palestinian territory inside Israel. Article 76 of the Fourth Geneva Convention prohibits the transfer of prisoners from occupied territory into the territory of the occupier. G4S services provided in these prisons include control and monitoring systems, visitation systems and CCTV systems.

G4S also provided equipment for Ofer prison in the West Bank, and provides equipment for Kishon and Moskobiyeh detention facilities, at which human rights organisations have documented systematic torture and ill treatment of Palestinian prisoners, including child prisoners.

G4S Israel has supplied luggage scanning equipment and full body scanners to several checkpoints in the West Bank, including the Qalandia checkpoint, the Bethlehem checkpoint and the Irtah (Sha'ar Efrain) checkpoint. Additionally, the company provides full body scanners to the Erez checkpoint in Gaza.
